GOLD RUSH TECH CHECK: 4TH FINGER DRONES

TECH CHECK INSTRUCTIONS: Gold Rush begins with a technique that many fiddle tunes share. The open E is played in addition to an A4, thus producing two of the same notes. This is a great example of how dissonance is used in folk music and can also be found in tunes like Sally Goodin or Tom and Jerry. A strong 4th finger is essential in intermediate fiddling, so avoid using your third or open strings as a replacement for this and start building your strength up!
